Why a Show Lease?

Our full leases offers a risk free and budget friendly way riders can obtain a show horse for an entire season. This gives riders the chance to hone their skills and expand their knowledge and experience. This program is designed for serious riders who are striving for competitive goals, and our lease horses can help do just that as they are able to perform at a higher ability than the average lesson horse.

What is Included?

Board/Care

- Stall board in boarder aisle with the same amenities as client owned horses
 - Private tack room, laundry facilities, hot/cold wash rack, fly sheet/blanketing
- Yearly maintenance included in lease price
 - Dental, coggins, vaccines, injections, wormer (shoeing not included)

Training/Showing

- Twice weekly private lessons with Head Trainer
 - Allows for more consistent progress in horse and rider
- Opportunity to show up to 12 shows per lease period.
 - Rider will have more chances to compete locally and/or rated and out of town.
- All necessary tack and equipment to get started is provided



Pricing

Expense Breakdown

Board & Lessons Package	\$1500/mo.
Farrier (every 6 weeks)	Starting at \$60, up to \$200. (dependent on horse)
Yearly Lease Fee	Starting at \$1500, up to \$5000. (dependent on horse)

Additional Info

Lease Date: 01/01 - 11/30

- Leases are timed in conjunction with USHJA and MOHJO show season schedules. This allows riders the opportunity to achieve year end point awards.
- Pro rate or lease extension options can be available on an ad hoc basis.
- You do NOT have to be an existing student of SFS to sign up for a year lease, however the options are given to current students first. The horse must also stay boarded and rider must lesson with us if part of the SFS Show Lease Program.

FAQs

Q. What is the minimum number of shows I have to participate in during my show lease?

a. We ask that you show at least 4 times during your lease. It does not matter if they are local and/or rated

Q. Can I lease the same horse two years in a row?

a. A this time we do not do back to back leases, but this may change in the future, so feel free to ask!

Q. What if I want to stop my lease before my lease is supposed to end?

a. You are allowed to break your lease at any point, however the lease will not be refunded but you will be able to stop your monthly package and farrier expense.

Q. What if my horse gets hurt for an extended period of time during my lease?

a. If your horse becomes out of commission at any point for longer than 6 weeks, you can either stop the lease and be refunded 60% of the remaining amount for the year, or pause your monthly package and resume when they are fit to perform again. Further details provided upon inquiry.
